If you have gently used items from the list below, OFPA can use them to generate funds to help the association help foster parents help the children placed in their care.

Items that we can accept in Usable Condition:

- Men's, women's, children's clothing of all seasons, sizes, and styles.
- Clothing accessories such as belts, purses, hats, gloves, ties, etc.
- Shoes of any kind.
- Bedding and bath items (sheets, blanket, towels)
- Draperies and curtains
- Small appliances and electrical items (clock radio, phones, can opener)
- Household and home décor items (lamps, pictures, flower pots)
- Kitchen items and glassware
- Toys and sports equipment
- Small - medium size furniture
- Books, videos, CD's, and DVD's
- Lawn and garden items (trimmers, buckets, sprinklers)
- Tools, hardware, and home improvement type items
- Holiday decorations and seasonal items

Items we cannot accept:

- Large appliances such as refrigerators, stoves, dishwashers, washers, dryers, freezers, hot water heaters, etc.
- Pianos or full size organs
- Hospital or Sofa beds
- X-Large console TV's
- Mattresses or box springs
- Scrap metal or excessively rusted items
- Outdoor swing sets, cribs, car seats
- Waterbeds
- Full size pool tables
- Guns, knives, ammunition, or weapons of any kind.
- Unpacked glass items
- Car batteries
- Flammable, combustible, or poisonous chemicals
- Paints or glues
- Food or liquor
- Clothing or bedding with animal hair, stains, or odor
- Broken, filthy, or unusable items of any kind
